Apologies as I truly believed I had gotten back to you on this. It was very helpful, and while a few things are still in the works, some things have been addressed and action was taken partially based on these suggestions. Here's a couple notes I want you to have and we're sharing with Kalra's office. Let me know if you have any other questions.

Arts and Entertainment Organizations: upcoming guidance on live performances will hopefully help clarify their status. No ETA yet.

Convention Centers: same thing, upcoming guidance will help clarify.

Longer lead time for tiers: I don't believe we're willing to consider any changes to lead times when moving to a more restrictive tier, but CDPH continues to work with counties. CDPH currently allows 3 days.

Website Ease of Use: We've made some changes to the website since this letter to address some concerns, like links to the guidance.

Continue commercial eviction moratorium authority: Done!
